This 1 kilo bar of gold was purchased by the staff of a scrap dealer in the United Kingdom on March 25, 2010.

The bar appeared to have the correct dimensions but was 2 grams underweight and would <u>not</u> have been noticed by an imprecise scale.

The bar was checked by a hand-held X-Ray Fluorescence Technology (XFF) that showed it to be 99.98% gold.

The bar came with its original certificate.

When checked, it was <u>not</u> ferro-magnetic.



The business owner that purchased the bar became suspicious when he realized the weight discrepancy and had the bar cropped.

He estimates between 30-40% of the weight of the bar to be Tungsten.

Tungsten has the same density as gold, so it would be easy to create counterfeit gold bars that are actually made of Tungsten and have a 1/16" layer of gold on the outside.
